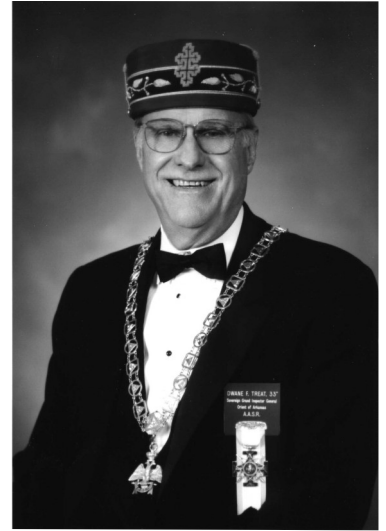

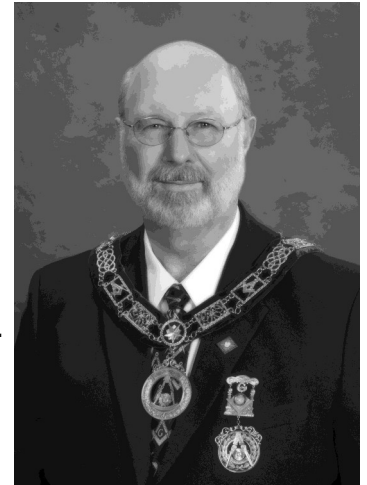

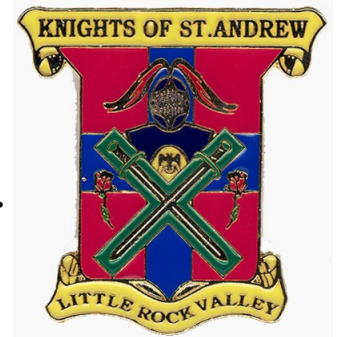

## The Knights of Saint Andrew



**Proverbs 8:33-- Hear instruction and be wise, and do not neglect it.**

It was the second Sunday in Advent and I heard my youngest daughter singing to herself as she stood in front of our Christmas tree.

“I see the love of God in you. The light of Christ comes shining through; and I am blessed to be with you, oh holy child of God.”

These lyrics are from her teaching she receives in the Catechesis of The Good Shepherd at The Cathedral School. I am transformed by the scene and recognize that it is these experiences that allow us to hear the voice of God. As you know, Catechesis is an education in the faith of children, young people and adults which includes especially the teaching of Christian doctrine imparted in an organic and systematic way, with a view to initiating the hearers into the fullness of Christian life. It was then that I noticed my copy of *Bridge to Light* on the table and I wondered; do you remember your Scottish Rite Catechesis?

I was initiated into the Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite in 2006. Those degrees presented in dramatic form during the Fall Reunion were instrumental in imparting a sample of the wisdom and fullness of The Rite. I would estimate that many of you may remember your Scottish Rite Catechesis, but may not know your Scottish Rite Catechesis. Brethren, the act of knowing requires time and study. We are chastened not to neglect our instruction, but at times we fall short. The Scottish Rite Master Craftsman program (<http://www.scottishrite.org/mastercraftsman.html>) provides a systematic approach to the study of our ritual and I strongly encourage the participation of all Scottish Rite Masons. *The Scottish Rite Ritual, Monitor and Guide*, is symbolic text. As such, it shares many of the same characteristics found in symbolic scripture. One of these common characteristics includes a powerful vocabulary. The use of the word “light” would be an example of this powerful vocabulary. In her book, *Written That You May Believe, Encountering Jesus in the Fourth Gospel*, Sandra M. Schneiders commented “...that the Fourth Gospel is a body of water in which a child can wade and an elephant can swim, that is, that even the simplest reader can understand it at one level whereas its meaning continues to deepen the longer one deals with it.” It is for this same reason that I love the liturgy of the Scottish Rite. Brother, holy child of God, know your Scottish Rite Catechesis.
